

Andrea D'Alessio

Dr Andrea D'Alessio is the Director of the Internal Medicine and Oncology Unit and Oncological Day Hospital of the San Marco Hospital in Zingonia (Bergamo).

He graduated in 1991 in Medicine and Surgery from the University of Pavia, where he specialized in Internal Medicine (1997). In 2014, he obtained a second specialization in Medical Oncology, at the University of Bicocca in Milan.

His career began in 1991, as a Medical Doctor at the San Matteo Polyclinic IRCCS. Subsequently, he held the positions of Medical Assistant for the Analysis Service and Department Assistant in the Military Hospital of Milan (1995–1996). He became 1st level Medical Director at the Medicine Department of the Lovere (Bergamo) Hospital (1996–1997), and then carried out his Help and Assistance activity in the Internal Medicine Department of the San Marco Hospital, between 1997 and 2003.

In 2005, he assumed the role of Assistant Reference in the Onco-Hematological Medicine Operative Unit of San Marco and then, in 2007, became its Manager, for which he still holds today. In addition to clinical activity, he places central venous catheters for CT and regularly performs ultrasound and Eco Doppler investigations for the diagnosis of oncological and thromboembolic diseases. He conducts educational activities in various universities in Milan, Italy, including the Università degli Studi di Milano, the Bicocca and the Vita-Salute San Raffaele University. He is the author and coauthor of about 20 publications, many congress abstracts and, during his career, he has participated as a speaker at more than 40 national congresses and conferences.
