

Domenico Gerbasi

Dr. Domenico Gerbasi graduated in Medicine and Surgery in July 1993 from the University of Modena and Specialized in General Surgery in July 1999 with full marks, including an internship in Lyon. After intense activity in general surgery and first aid, at the end of a specialization course in breast cancer and reconstructive surgery through an internship at the IEO of Milan, Dr Domenico Gerbasi has actively and dedicated his time to breast cancer and reconstructive surgery, carrying out thousands of operations to date. Subsequently, he was appointed as the first Head of the Breast Surgery Unit of the A.S.S.T. Bergamo Est (ex A.O. Bolognini) since 2009 and then, to date, Head of the Coordination of the Breast Unit of the A.S.S.T. Bergamo Est. In 2011, he published in "Updates in Surgery", the official magazine of the Italian Society of Surgery, a new original surgical technique of breast cancer surgery without visible scars, which he conceived and carried out for the first time in Seriate (BG). In May 2012, by invitation, he presented his technique of conservative breast care for cancer with extramammary access at the 5th Annual World Cancer Congress in Beijing (China), which was received with interest and proposed again in 2013 by invitation as President session at the "Target Meeting 2nd World Cancer online Conference" in Texas (USA)
