

Roberto Labianca

Prof Roberto Labianca graduated in Medicine and Surgery with Honors in 1975 and specialized in Oncology with absolute marks and Honors (1978) and Allergology and Immunology with absolute marks (1981).

He obtained national eligibility for Medical Oncology Primary in 1989. Since May 2014, he has been the Director of the Palliative Care and Hospice Unit. Since November 2013, he has been Director of the Cancer Center of Pope John XXIII. Since 2004, he has been Director of the Inter-company Oncological Department of the Province of Bergamo. From June 2008 to October 2013, he was Director of the Department of Oncology and Hematology of the Bergamo Hospital. From 1999 to 2008, he was Director of the Medical Oncology Unit of the Ospedali Riuniti of Bergamo.

His main activities are specific anti-tumor and support therapy for patients suffering from all solid tumors (in particular, the gastrointestinal tract, breast, lung); palliative care (simultaneous care and end-of-life therapies); and multidisciplinary integration with specialists experts in individual pathologies.

He has a long experience in coordinating a complex and multidisciplinary team (doctors, nurses, data managers, hospital pharmacists), both in terms of clinical assistance and translational and clinical research. He is a Professor of Medical Oncology at the Oncology Specialty Schools of the University of Insubria and at the University of Pavia. He has participated as a Speaker at numerous national and international courses and congresses. He is the author and coauthor of 320 publications on PubMed.
